We are THRILLED to welcome back Grammy-nominated vocalist and violinist Tracy Bonham Fine to teach this popular camp! A native of Eugene, Tracy began singing at age 5, playing the violin



at age 9, and studying piano at age 12. She is also a graduate of ESYO's Youth Symphony! Her 1996 major label debut, The Burdens of Being Upright (Island), went gold in the US, Australia, and parts of Europe. Her hit single, Mother Mother, led to a pair of Grammy nominations in 1997. Bonham has released five subsequent albums and two EPs and has toured the world many times. She has appeared on The Tonight Show With Jay Leno, Late Night with Conan O'Brien, and Late Late Show with Craig Fergusson. Tracy has also appeared as guest vocalist / violinist with artists such as Blue Man Group, Juliana Hatfield, Aerosmith, Wayfaring Strangers, Latin Playboys, Jimmy Page and Robert Plant.



Dale Bradley, cellist, composer and guitarist, is a Springfield native and a longtime member of the Eugene Symphony and the Oregon Mozart Players. A graduate of the UO School of Music, he studied with Robert Hladky and Hal Owen. Dale started playing cello and composing in 4th grade, filling up small notebooks with

musical ideas. His compositions and arrangements have been played live across the west coast, from local retirement centers to the LA Philharmonic! Dale teaches beginning ESYO String Academy classes in elementary schools and has a private studio for cello, bass & guitar. Dale has played live and recorded with a wide variety of musicians. His own CDs include "Solo," "The Christmas Cello" and "Generations."
