Award-winning artist and Hawaii native **Neal Chin** has taught and performed ukulele for 17 years. His clear and direct enthusiasm for music has come to life in countless concerts, workshops, and private instruction.

Neal won his first Nā Hōkū Hanohano Award in 2014 for his contribution to The Akira Project. His latest release 'Ukulele



Paintings has been nominated for the 2016 'Ukulele Album of the Year by the Hawai'i Academy of Recording Arts. Neal currently lives, teaches, and performs in Seattle.

Joe Aloia is an active NW musician with a passion for teaching; he plays bass, guitar, and ukulele. He earned his M.A. in jazz studies at the U of O while performing regularly with groups of jazz, blues, rock, pop, and classical backgrounds. His specialties are musicality and group performance. WHAT IS EUGENE-SPRINGFIELD YOUTH ORCHESTRAS (ESYO)?

ESYO's mission is to inspire and lead students on a journey of discovery through orchestral instruction and performance. We do this by offering the highest-quality instruction progressing from beginning classes to advanced orchestras, offering need-based program and private lesson scholarships, and collaborating with area schools and arts organizations.

ESYO's sequential orchestral program includes five levels of orchestral training designed for students from grade four through age 21. For grade-schoolers, our partnership with elementary schools provides vital beginning classes through our String Academy program. Students can then move up to String Academy 2 and continue on to three auditioned ensembles: Little Symphony (strings only), Junior Orchestra and the Eugene-Springfield Youth Symphony (both full symphonic orchestras). 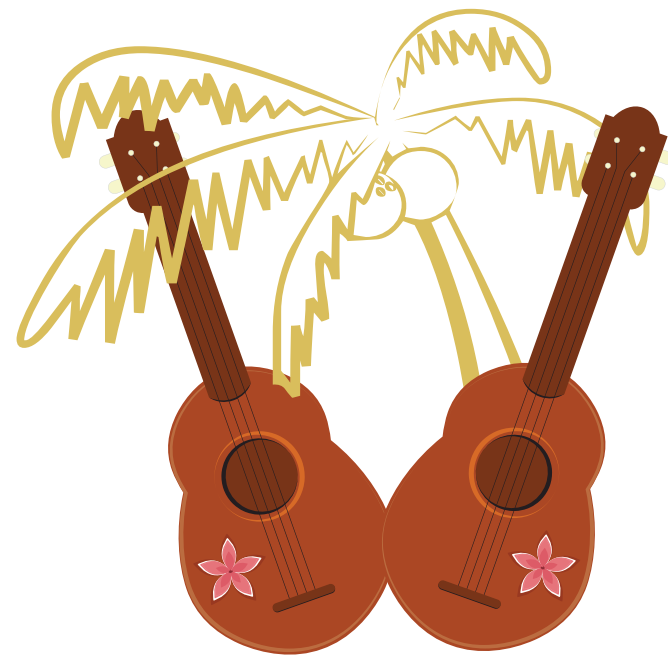
