## WHY DOES THIS MATTER? HOW WILL MY CHILD BENEFIT?

- >> Develop other skills such as: critical thinking, creative problem solving, effective communication, teamwork and more.
- >> Keeps students engaged in a healthy activity that can boost self-confidence.
- >> Offers a personal level of appreciation for music and the arts.
- >> Helps students achieve in other academic subjects like math, science and reading.
- >> Enhances discipline, patience, responsibility, cooperation and awareness.
- >> Allows students to collaborate and help each other within their group and with peers from other schools.
- >> Students with coursework/experience in music performance and music appreciation scored higher on the SAT than students with no arts participation. (*College-Bound Seniors National Report: Profile of SAT Program Test Takers,* Princeton, NJ: The College Entrance Examination Board, 2001)
- >> U.S. Department of Education data show that students who report consistently high levels of involvement in instrumental music during the middle and high school years show significantly higher levels of mathematics proficiency by 12th grade. (*Catterall, J., Chapleau, R., and Iwanaga, J., "Involvement in the Arts and Human Development," 1999*)
