## MEET THE INSTRUCTORS

Dale Bradley, cellist, composer and guitarist, is a Springfield native and a longtime member of the Eugene Symphony and the Oregon Mozart Players. A graduate of the UO School of Music, he studied with Robert Hladky and Hal Owen. Dale started playing cello and composing in 4th grade, filling up small notebooks with musical ideas. His compositions and arrangements have been played live across the west coast, from local retirement centers to the LA Philharmonic! Dale teaches beginning ESYO String Academy classes in elementary schools and has a private studio for cello, bass & guitar. Dale has played live and recorded with a wide variety of musicians. His own CDs include "Solo," "The Christmas Cello" and "Generations."



Julia Frantz performs as a soloist, chamber musician and orchestral violinist throughout North America and Europe. A Eugene native, she has been a member of the Eugene Symphony since 2015 and regularly performs with the Oregon Mozart Players and other local ensembles. Julia holds a Bachelor of Music from Rice Univ. and a Master of Music from the Univ. of Maryland. She has participated in music festivals such as the National Repertory Orchestra and the AIMS Institute in Austria. Julia has played fiddle since the age of five with country, rock, and hip hop groups throughout Oregon. She is an alum of ESYO's Youth Symphony, coaches the Ambassador Musician program, and also teaches two String Academy at two schools. Julia looks forward to working with young musicians this summer!

## WHAT IS EUGENE-SPRINGFIELD YOUTH ORCHESTRAS (ESYO)?

ESYO's mission is to inspire and lead students on a journey of discovery through orchestral instruction and performance. We do this by offering the highest-quality instruction progressing from beginning classes to advanced orchestras, offering need-based program and private lesson scholarships, and collaborating with area schools and arts organizations.

ESYO's sequential orchestral program includes five levels of orchestral training designed for students from grade four through age 21. For grade-schoolers, our partnership with elementary schools provides vital beginning classes through our String Academy program. Students can then move up to String Academy 2 and continue on to three auditioned ensembles: Little Symphony (strings only), Junior Orchestra and the Eugene-Springfield Youth Symphony (both full symphonic orchestras).
