

Eugene-Springfield Youth Orchestras (ESYO) Job Opening – Little Symphony Conductor

ESYO seeks applicants for conductor of ESYO's Little Symphony, a part-time position for the 2019-20 season. ESYO is a nonprofit organization providing music education and performance opportunities for students of all backgrounds in the Eugene/Springfield area in Oregon. Our mission is to inspire and lead students on a journey of discovery through orchestral instruction and performance. We do this by offering the highest quality instruction progressing from beginning classes to advanced orchestras, providing need-based program and private lesson scholarships, and collaborating with area schools and arts organizations.

Little Symphony (LS) is the first of ESYO's three auditioned ensembles. It is a string ensemble with about 30-35 young musicians. It serves as a training orchestra for the full Junior Orchestra (JO) in ESYO's sequential orchestral program. Students usually remain in LS for two or more years before auditioning into JO.

Requirements

- Strings education and performance background
- Exceptional musicianship and conducting skills
- Music-related college degree
- Significant experience working with youth musicians from age 8 and up;
- A proven record of success with audience relations and innovative programming;
- Confidence and patience to motivate and inspire young musicians;
- Strong communication, collaboration, and leadership skills;
- Oregon residents preferred.

Responsibilities

- Develop the artistic vision and conduct the Little Symphony (LS);
- Coordinate and supervise orchestra's activities including, but not limited to, rehearsals, and concerts;
- Conduct and lead LS rehearsals on Monday afternoons from 4:15-5:45pm from Sept-May.
- Present and conduct at least four concerts per season, two formal concerts in December and May, and one outreach concert each in the fall and the spring.
- Arrange and oversee orchestral coaching for the orchestra;
- Work collaboratively with the other ESYO conductors and Executive Director to:
 - Recruit students to audition for LS.
 - o Attend spring and fall auditions and help prepare placement lists (early June and Sept).
 - o Select appropriate music for LS.
- Work with board members, staff, and registrars to help with marketing materials, concert programs, fundraising events, outreach projects, ticket sales, special events, and recognition;
- Participate in the governance of the orchestra by reporting to the ESYO board of directors as requested;
- Assist in the promotion of the orchestra by being available for public appearances;
- Collaborate with Executive Director and ESYO Board in planning and programming for the orchestra.
